ALICE-ROSE

The Alice-Rose room is an ode to travel and the past, named after the eldest daughter of Martien Jullian, the patron of this late 19th-century folly.

The room is styled with iconic William Morris wallpaper with art deco motifs, an old travel trunk as a wardrobe and a gypsy-style velvet sofa in shades of English green.

Alice-Rose also has one of the turrets which we have transformed into a reading and meditation room.

The bathroom, with its geometrically shaped earthenware tiles and antique cement tile floor, offers a lovely view of the dome made of glazed Burgundy tiles.

The cast iron bathtub, with its eagle claw feet completes the journey.

Finally, from the large windows of the Alice-Rose room, you can enjoy the view of the garden and the Canal du Midi.





MARGUERITE

The Marguerite room is a tribute to Martien Jullian's youngest daughter.

Each element evokes the poetry and relaxing atmosphere of the garden that **has been infused into this room**: from the **Laura Ashley** wallpaper depicting a giant wisteria, to the Japanese cherry tree-patterned tiles, to the dried flower pendant lights.

The open-plan bathroom and its freestanding bathtub add a touch of romanticism to this cocoon, where time seems to stand still.

Finally, from the windows, you can enjoy the view of the garden and the Canal du Midi.



VALENTINE

The Valentine room honors Martien Jullian's wife.

This 40m² master bedroom, decorated in shades of blue and resolutely **Haussmannian in style**, offers two private outdoor spaces:

- a small balcony overlooking the garden
- **a large 20m² furnished terrace, facing south, overlooking the Canal du Midi.**

Decoratively, **it revisits the 1960s and 1970s**, with its Scandinavian furniture, a **Verner Panton** reissue chandelier with mother-of-pearl tassels, and an embroidered rug by **Wendy Morrison**.

Several living spaces coexist in the Valentine bedroom:

- an office
- a seating area with a sofa bed that can be converted into a child's bed.

The bathroom, decorated in powder pink tones with touches of gold, houses a large walk-in shower and **a castle turret, transformed into a small boudoir**.

Like our kitchen, which strives to be eco-responsible, our materials and equipment have been carefully considered as:

- we have opted for a green electricity supplier
- our bedding is made from 100% natural materials (organic latex, wood, cotton percale, linen, etc.)
- to preserve water resources, a precious commodity, we only replace your bathroom linens upon request. To avoid waste, we encourage you to check that the taps are turned off after use.
- We avoid plastics as much as possible, favoring glass, and favor the digitization of documents over the excessive use of paper.
- For waste, we provide a separate bag for recyclable packaging.
- We have banned the use of capsule coffee machines. However, upon request, and at no extra charge, we will be happy to serve you coffee from our independent roaster or tea from Mariage Frères. Don't hesitate to ask us during your stay!

During his career spanning over 30 years in Paris, Charles launched and managed several bistro-mic restaurants, some of which he owned.

He started as sous-chef to Michelin-starred chef Philippe Renard (Hôtel Scribe, Paris Opéra), and then worked in several Parisian establishments, enriching his knowledge and skills.

Since 2023, he has decided to settle down in Béziers.

Each meal is served by the light of the stained-glass windows of our former billiard room, or in our English-style flower garden, weather permitting, in the shade of our century-old magnolia and linden trees.

The antique tableware completes your culinary experience, recalling the poetic and romantic world of Maison Jullian.

The tableware has been carefully crafted to pay homage to the history of this typical meal, unique to Béziers.

Period porcelain hand-picked piece by piece, exceptional silverware, everything has been designed to make this moment a timeless ritual.

You can enjoy English specialties and great French pastry classics: scones, homemade jams, cream, an assortment of sandwiches, an assortment of biscuits, a pastry, and unlimited hot drinks (Mariage Frères teas, old-fashioned hot chocolate, organic coffee, etc.)

THE GARDEN

"The countryside in the city" is the identity of Maison Jullian. An enchanted interlude, a well-hidden gem, just a few minutes minute walk from the train station and Béziers city center.

Besides the building itself, what fascinates and captivates upon arrival at Maison Jullian is the atmosphere of tranquility that emanates from the 2,000m² English-style park facing the Canal du Midi.
